Imagine: You're standing under a vast canopy of stars, or on the beach looking at the horizon that ends at the distant curve of earth, or on a mountain peak taking in...well, the vastness of creation. That feeling stirs, what? Exhilaration, awe, an initial wow! and then, perhaps, a quieting of the heart and mind? When people say they're "spiritual', many will point to an experience of wonder, reflecting Rabbi Abraham Heschel's observation that "All religion begins in awe." We'll explore different dimensions of this common, holy experience in the 4week series, We'll consider how we fit in the grand scheme of things in relation to Nature, History, Culture and the Sacred. Rev. Dan will share images and reflections from his Sabbatical on this theme, opening into questions for reflection, small group discussion and shared consideration.

The Gospel of John with Rev David Ewart

The Gospel of John is the most intensely personal and clearly directed at we the readers of any of the four Bible accounts of Jesus. It is the only one to explicitly say that it was written so that we might believe in Jesus. This four week programme will read through the whole book guided by the questions: Who is Jesus? Who am I? Who do I trust? Each week there will be opportunities for small group discussion, prayerful listening to the text, historical background to life and times of Jesus, and time for questions. David Ewart is a retired United Church ordained minister who was an active ally in the 1985 full inclusion of LGTBQ persons in the United Church and regularly writes on the future of the United Church.
