## **Covid Protocols at St Andrew's Wesley for Small Groups and Events**

Small Group Gatherings or Events that are not a worship service

- 1. You will be asked to show your <u>Covid passport</u> every time you attend until we get to a point where we can store it in the church builder app.
- 2. If we know you, we will not ask for photo ID. If we do not know you or can't tell due to your mask, we will ask for photo ID and may ask you to pull down your mask so we can see your face.
- 3. Unfortunately, you will not be allowed to attend a small group gathering or an event if you are not fully vaccinated. (Please speak to <u>Diane Mitchell</u> if you have a medical exemption)
- 4. Masks are mandatory indoors, even when seated.
- 5. Hand sanitizer and wipes are provided in all rooms.
- 6. We will continue to have many meetings and programs online due to the complications of in person meetings.
- 7. If food is being served (we highly discourage this)—it must be served to seated participants, with tongs and no touching of the food. People do not self serve. Food must come from a licenced food safe facility (restaurant, or caterer).
- 8. Unfortunately, as much as we care about the environment, at this moment we will be serving food in individual containers so there will be more garbage than normal.
- 9. We ask that you bring your own beverage in your own container for safety.
- 10. Coffee is currently not being served as there is too much chance of people moving around and gathering too closely.

## **Covid Protocols at St Andrew's Wesley for Worship**

If you're interested in joining us in person for worship on Sunday it is important to us that:

- 1. We encourage everyone to wear masks while in the building at all times (disposable masks are available, if you forget yours).
- 2. If you are unwell, that you stay home until you are feeling better
- 3. We recommend using the hand sanitizer at each entrance and in our Sunday Club rooms
- 4. We maintain physical distancing from others, whenever possible. We have roped off rows to create distancing and ushers will be helping people access seating. It is helpful

for families to sit on the aisle so that when it comes time for Sunday Club (10am service only) they are able to leave with minimum contact.

- 5. Sadly, we are not serving refreshments before or after our services
- 6. We follow the direction of staff and volunteer greeting team
- 7. Offering baskets will not be passed during the worship but available at each doorway following worship
- 8. You are aware that at any time you might end up on camera on the live stream (10am service only)
